Vredefort Dome, situated approximately 120km southwest of Johannesburg, dates back 2,023 million years and is the oldest, largest and most deeply eroded complex meteorite impact structure in the world. It is the site of the world's greatest single known energy release event. It contains high quality and accessible geological (outcrop) sites which demonstrates a range of geological evidences of a complex meteorite impact structure. The Vredefort Dome was declared a World Heritage Site in 2005 by UNESCO. A World Heritage Site is a recognised and protected area of outstanding natural, historical and cultural value.

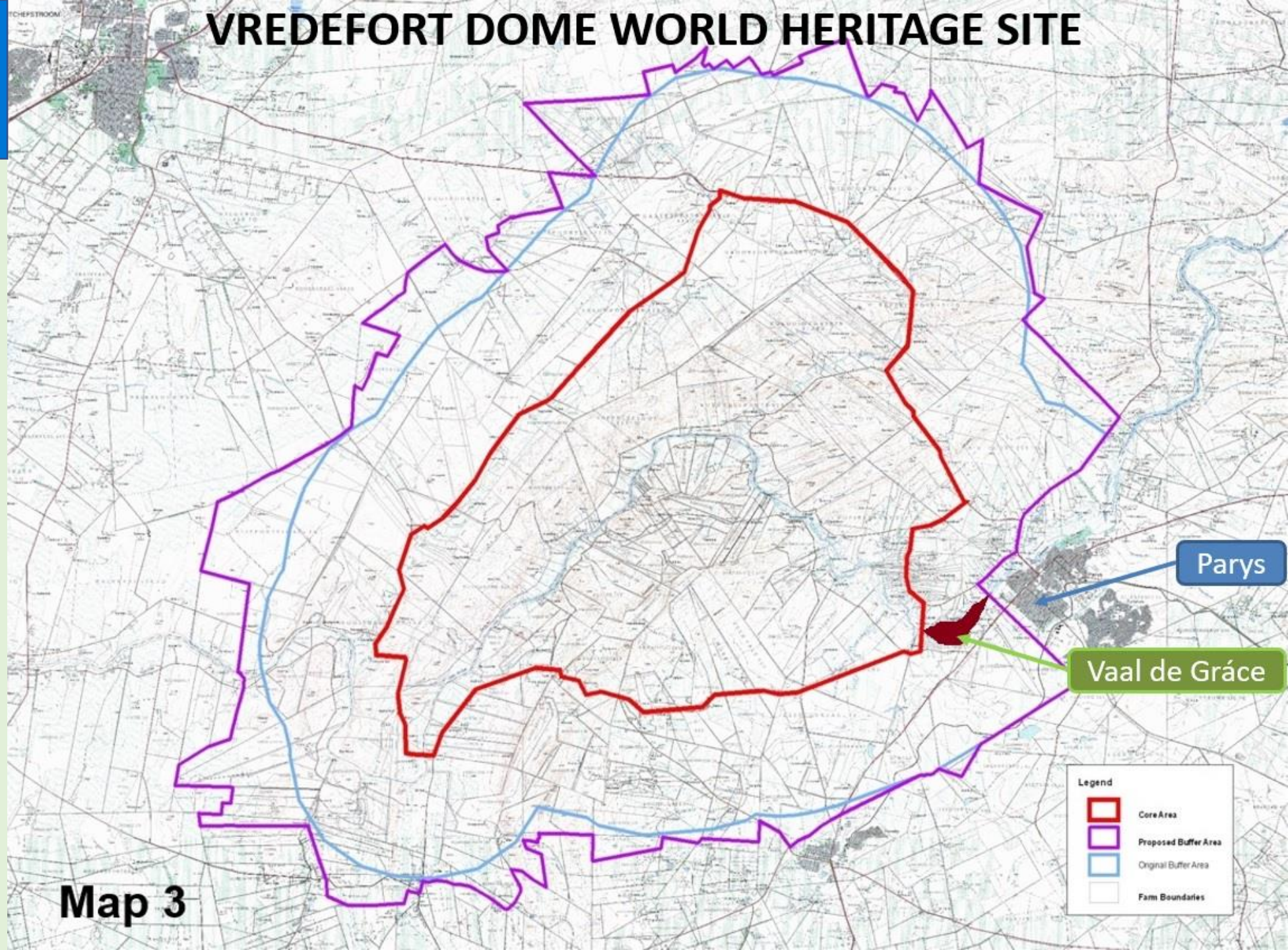


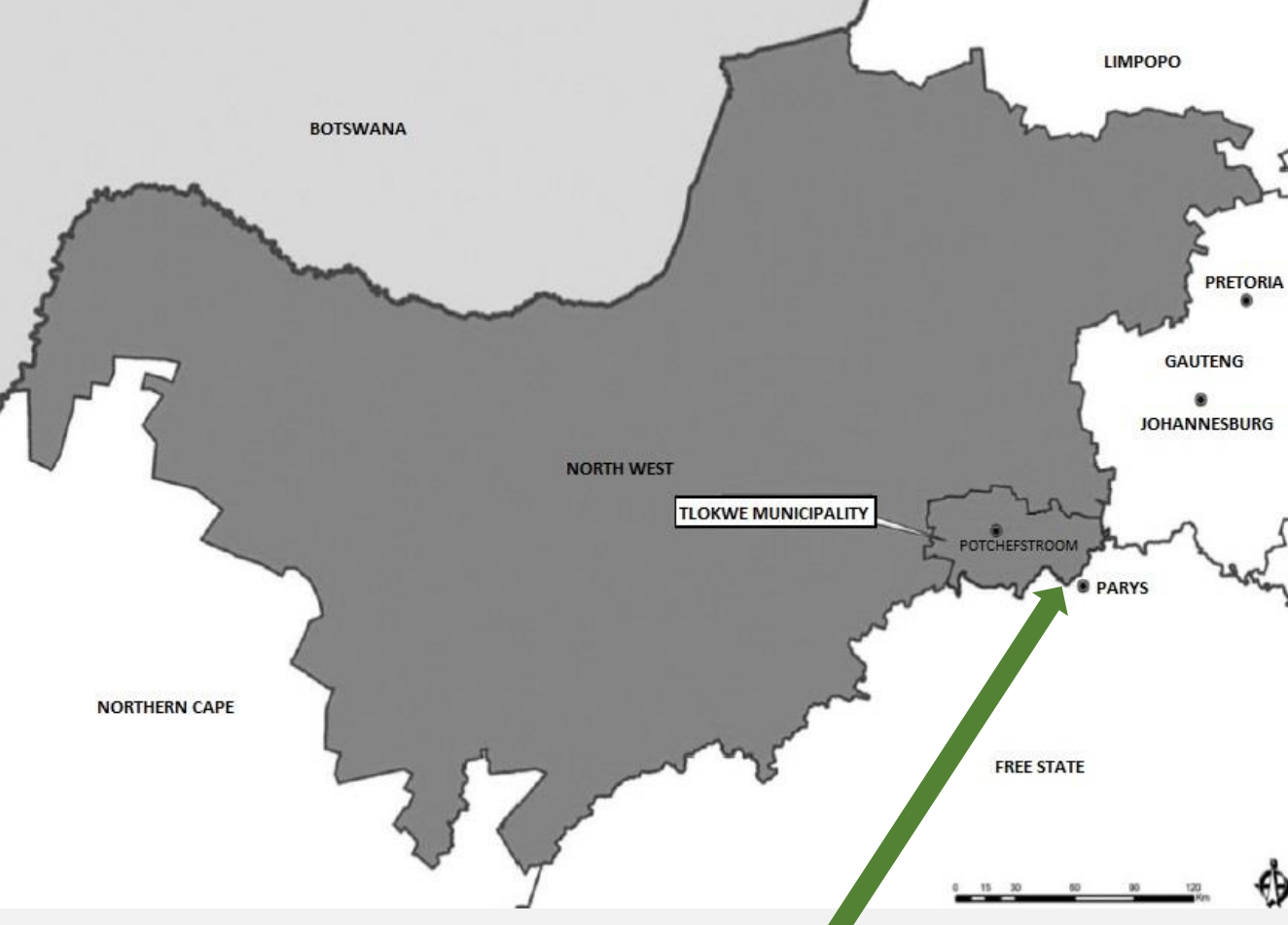
The mighty Vaal River is the largest tributary of the Orange River in South Africa. It has its source in the Drakensberg Mountains in Mpumalanga, east of Johannesburg and about 30km north of Ermelo and only 240km from the Indian Ocean. It then flows westwards to its conjunction with the Orange River southwest of Kimberley in the Northern Cape. The Vaal River is 1120km in length, and forms the border between Mpumalanga, Gauteng and North West Province on the north bank, and the Free State on its south.



VREDEFORT DOME WORLD HERITAGE SITE

The serial World Heritage property which is about 30,111 ha, is made up of a main component area of 30,108 ha and 3 satellite components of 1 ha each. The property of the Vredefort Dome includes key geological (outcrop) sites which demonstrate classic complex meteorite impact structure phenomena. A comprehensive comparative analysis with other complex meteorite impact structures demonstrated that it is the only example on earth providing a full geological profile of an astrobleme below the crater floor, thereby enabling research into the genesis and development of an astrobleme immediately post impact. This serial property is surrounded by a 5 km buffer zone that is designed to ensure the property's long term protection against external development threats.

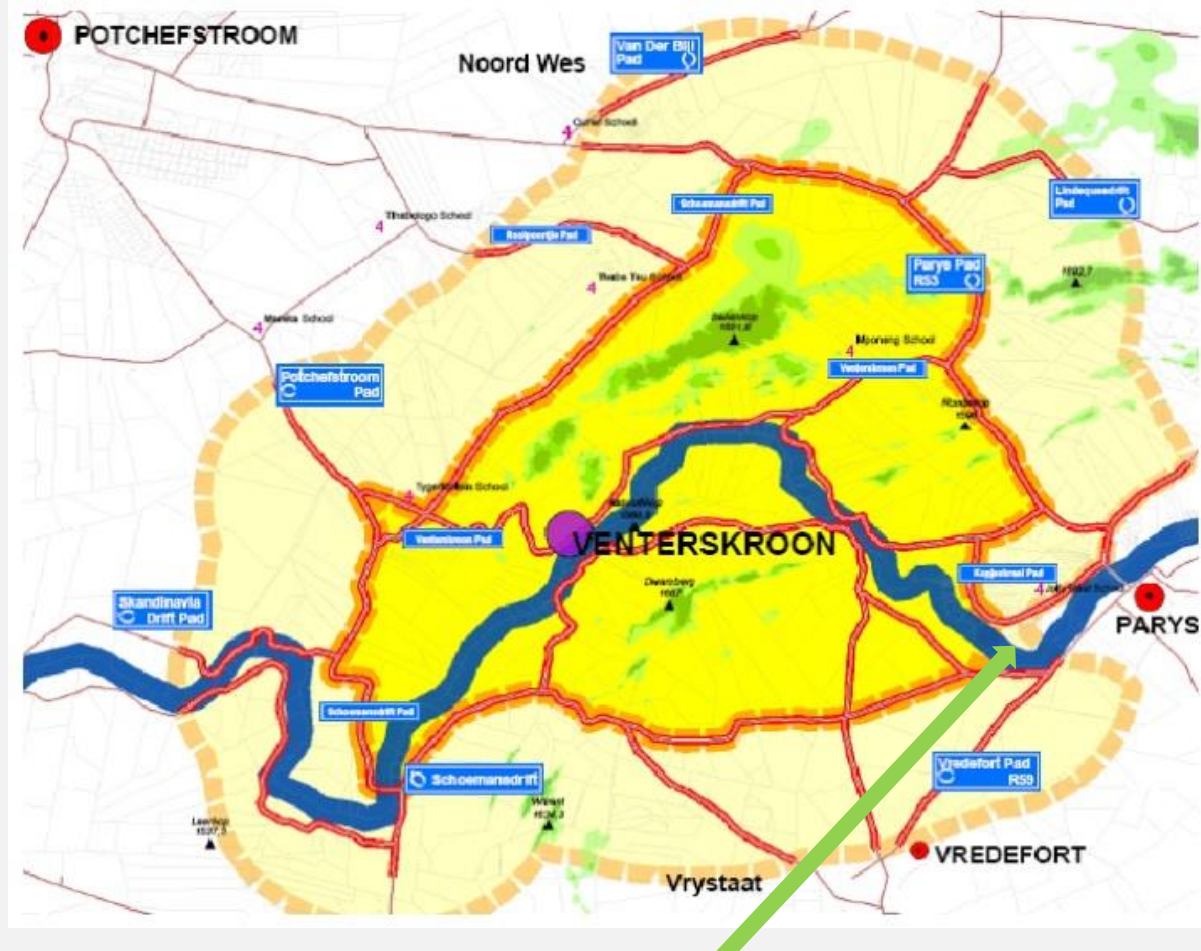




Vaal de Grâce Estate is regulated by the Tlokwe Local Municipality (before February 2007 the Potchefstroom Local Municipality).

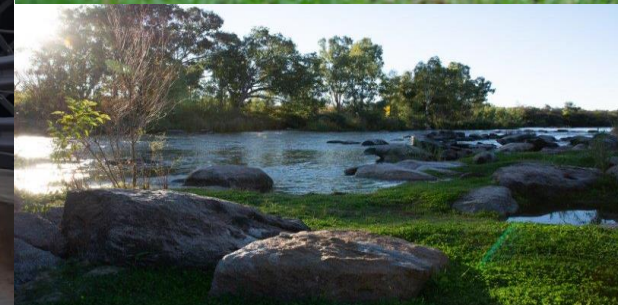
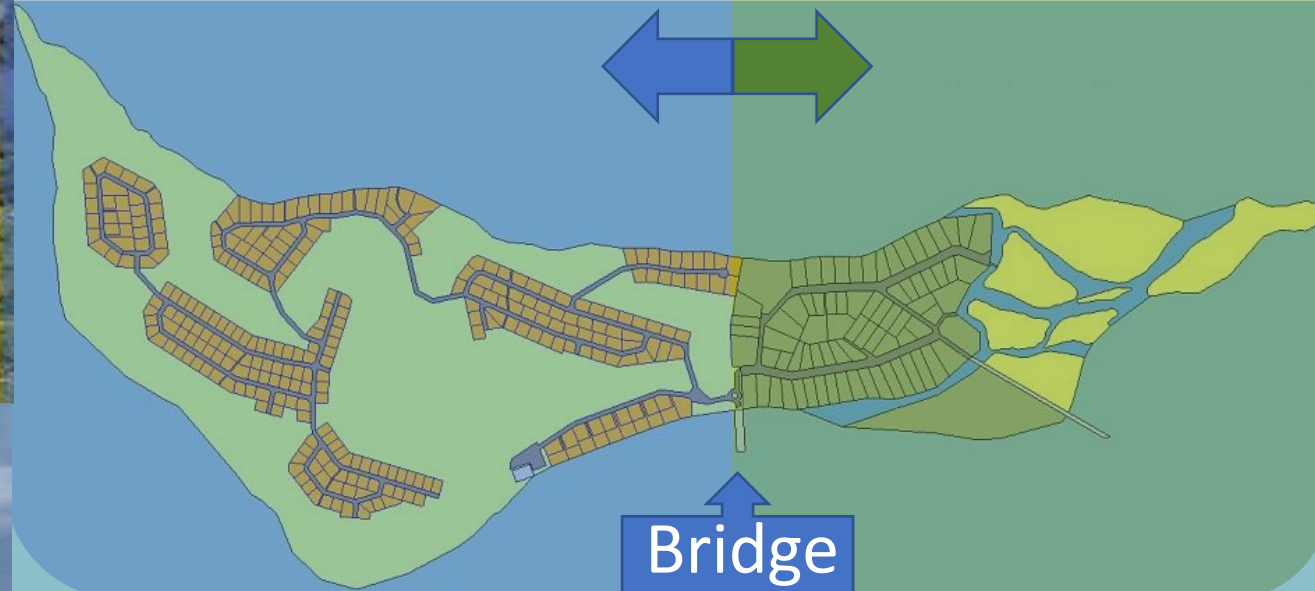
